PUBLIC NOTICE

Kind Attention: All units/ entities engaged in Manufacturing, Import, Stoking, Distribution, Sale and Use of identified Single Use Plastic (SUP) commodities.

Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India has prohibited Manufacturing,
 Import, Stoking, Distribution, Sale and Use of following identified SUP commodities w.e.f. 1st July, 2022:-

1. Ear buds with plastic sticks

2. Plastic sticks for balloons

3. Plastic flags

4. Candy sticks

5. Ice-cream sticks

6. Polystyrene (Thermocol)

for decoration

7. Plates

8. Cups

9. Glasses

10. Forks

11. Spoons

12. Knives

13. Straw

14. Trays

15. Wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes

Cigarette packets

18. Plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron

- In case of doubt w.r.t. above 19 banned SUPs commodities, you may seek clarification on <u>E-mail: supdo-ubts@gmail.com</u>.
- Apart from above 19 banned SUP commodities, following commodities are also prohibited under PWM Rules, 2016 as amen ded till date:-
 - Carry bags made of virgin or recycled plastic less than 75 microns in thickness [120 microns in thickness w.e.f. 31st December, 2022].
 - Plastic sheet or like used for packaging, wrapping the commodity less than 50 microns in thickness [except where the thickness of such plastic sheets impair the functionality of the product].
 - · Sachets using plastic material used for storing, packing or selling gutkha, tobacco and pan masala.
 - · Non-woven plastic carry bags less than 60 Gram per Square Meter (GSM).
- Grievances with respect to manufacturing of banned SUP items and sale/ storage of banned SUP items and other violations of provisions of PWM Rules, 2016 can be lodged through:-
 - 1. "Green Delhi App", a Mobile App of Delhi Govt.
 - 2. "SUP-CPCB", a Mobile App of CPCB.
